<b>Item</b>	<b>Purpose</b>
<b>Full Names</b> *	To identify the applicant(s).
<b>Title(s)</b> *	To enable us to address the applicant(s) correctly.
<b>Date of Birth</b> *	As we have a fee structure which varies with a member's age, we need this as a basis from which to calculate age.
<b>Birthplace</b>	We are required to enter this on a member's international membership card ( INF 'Passport').
<b>Occupation</b>	We are a member run organisation and like to know what skills are available within the membership
<b>Home Address</b> *	This is normally the destination for club newsletters and notices.
<b>E-Mail Address</b>	This, if available, can ensure early receipt of urgent notices
<b>Home Phone Number</b> *	Required so that the applicant(s) can be advised by telephone of any 'short notice' social activity. We provide for the situation where a member does NOT wish to be telephoned.
<b>Notices to (if other)</b>	Refer above (Home Address) - this is an alternative address for notices.
<b>Have you been a Naturist Club member before ?</b>	We may need to obtain a confidential reference from your previous club(s).

## JOINING PROCEDURE

Any application to join is usually followed by an interview by two committee members, usually at the applicants home or on the grounds if it is more convenient. The application is then discussed at the next committee meeting, voted on and approved or declined. The applicants are then notified by mail and told what their membership fees are. Usually the joining fee plus pro-rata on balance of our financial year.

We are still in effect on probation and any membership can be terminated with reasonable cause. This procedure is detailed in the club rules. Due to the restrictions on single members in some cases they may have to go on the waiting list.

Any member can apply for a permanent site, this enables a caravan to be left there for them to use when ever. This is at the discretion of the committee. Where possible the caretaker should be notified if the power point is not required especially around Christmas and New Year when the grounds are generally full.

**HAPPY HOUR** — It is a tradition at the club when there are a few members or visitors present to have drinks together at around 5pm (4pm during the winter months). Most club activities cease then. It is a good opportunity to introduce new faces. It is a BYO and the hour is optional.

**POT LUCK TEA** — When a pot luck tea is proposed it usually means that each family brings a dish for the table. It can be a salad, pizza, vegetables, pasta or whatever. Theme night functions are usually held once a month and take the form of a Pot Luck Dinner with a theme applied to food and attire.
