How to find Rapere

From Napier (22km) leave by either Prebensen Drive or Church Road onto Puketitiri Road. 4km before Rissington turn right onto Glengarry Road for 400m to Rapere entrance signposted on right.

From Hastings (32km) exit by Omahu Road to Fernhill. Take Swamp Road then right onto Omarunui Road, quickly turn left towards Puketapu across river then left into Dartmoor Road. Soon turn right into Apley Road then right onto Puketitiri Road to soon reach on left Glengarry Road as above.

From Taupo on SH5 12km after Te Pohue turn R onto Glengarry Road for 14km (partly gravel) to reach Rapere signposted on L

From Wairoa. From SH2 at Bay View turn R onto Hill Rd through village. Soon turn L into Seafield Rd then R onto Puketitiri Rd. to reach Glengarry Rd. as above.

Set in rolling hills near Rissington, with lots of lawns, trees and modern amenities, Rapere is the perfect place to throw off all your stress and cares with your clothes. We invite you to come and see for yourself . . .*

Rapere.

Our 2.5 hectare property is partly flat and partly rolling hillsides with screened boundaries, lots of trees, a tiny lake and plenty of places to picnic, sunbathe, camp or roam and explore.

Rapere is always open and available for members and visitors to use and come and go as they please.

Facilities.

Clubhouse We have a 250 sq.m building with lounge, a well equipped kitchen and dining area, and space for functions and games, table tennis and pool tables. A wood stove keeps it warm in cold weather. In the basement are toilets, showers, laundry and a spa room.

Swimming Pool. We have a 19x9m filtered pool with adjacent toddlers pool - It's the favourite gathering place on sunny days.

Games. We have courts for miniten, volleyball, deck tennis, putting and petanque.

Children's Play areas. We have well equipped play facilities inside and outside with swings, seesaws, flying fox and shaded sandpit.

Shaded Barbecue Area. Members can use our gas heated barbecue and tables and chairs.

Accommodation and Camping.

Norm's Lodge. The original farm cottage has been refurbished with a well equipped Kitchen, Lounge/Dining room with open fireplace, toilet, shower and bath, three bedrooms with double bed and a single bed, (one with a cot) making

a total of 10 beds. It is available to members and visitors for overnight stays and holidays. (See under costs.) It is wise to book ahead. You will need to bring your own food, towels, bed linen and blankets/duvets.

Camping. We have many places to pitch tents and park caravans and campervans, several with 230v power available.

Permanent Sites. Members can lease sites to locate their own cabins, baches, caravans or campervans where they spend weekends and holidays relaxing at Rapere



Activities.

At Rapere we enjoy swimming, games, picnicing, chatting with friends, sunbathing, lazing in a warm sunny spot, or perhaps in a cool shady spot.

We organise social functions, barbecues, parties and dinners at Rapere, and on occasions beach trips and restaurant outings. Sometimes these are dressed occasions when we can invite friends.

Since taking over the property in 1963 all of our facilities have been constructed by our members. To keep our subscriptions reasonable we do our own maintenance and construction ourselves. No one is obliged to help, but most find the effort very satisfying.

Membership.

Our club is family oriented with a good balance between younger and older couples and single people. Total numbers vary, but is usually between 50 and 100 adult plus children.

Our Club

Hawke's Bay Naturist Club is a registered Incorporated Society owned and run by our members. Annual and Half Annual general meetings are held to elect our Officers and committee, decide policy and discuss members ideas and concerns.

A committee meets monthly and whenever else necessary to manage day to day club affairs. All members are welcome to attend these meetings except when confidential matters are being discussed.

Affiliations.

We are affiliated to the N.Z. Naturist Federation and the International Naturist Federation. Our members receive an international passport which allows them to visit any other affiliated club worldwide.
